ITINERARY

Day 1: Flight from Spain to Ecuador (GYE or UIO). Arrival in the afternoon and overnight in a guesthouse.

Day 2: Flight to Baltra (GPS). Assistance at the airport and transfer to the "Aqua" yacht. Welcome briefing. In the afternoon, first "check dive".

Day 3: We will arrive at Cape Marshall. 3 dives are planned for the area. Sailing afternoon.

Day 4: We will arrive at the mythical Darwin. Day of 4 dives in the area.

Day 5: 2 dives in Darwin. Navigation to Wolf Island (2 more dives).

Day 6: Day of 3 dives around Wolf Island. Navigation to Isabela Island.

Day 7: In Isabela, you will dive at Punta Vicente Roca. We will sail to Cape Douglas, to dive there with the marine iguanas.

Day 8: Two morning dives at Roca Cousin. In the afternoon, land excursion to the upper part of Santa Cruz.

Day 9: After breakfast, check out and transfer to Baltra airport to take the flight back to Spain.

Day 10: Arrival in Spain. End of services provided.

INCLUDED SERVICES:

- Transfer Airport GPS - Yacht "Aqua".
- 8 days / 7 nights of full board accommodation on board the boat "Aqua" in a shared double cabin.
- Water, infusions, coffee and snacks 24 hours aboard the "Aqua".

- "Nautilus Lifeline GPS" during the dives.
- 2 Diving guides certified by the Galapagos National Park.
